Over three sessions in December, two Victorian secondary students will join percussionist Eugene Ughetti (Artistic Director, Speak Percussion) and sound engineer Michael Hewes to learn about the recording process.

Ughetti and Hewes will be recording works by three of Australia's most innovative composers (Thomas Meadowcroft, James Rushford and Alexander Garsden) alongside excerpts from three of Speak Percussion's most original projects: Transducer, Assembly Operation and Polar Force. These works will be featured on Ughetti's upcoming debut album, to be released in 2020.

Students will be invited into the Run Stop Sound recording studio, where they will have the opportunity to learn about score preparation, microphone set up and placement, mixing, mastering and more. This internship is ideal for students interested in pursuing a career in sound engineering, composition and/or musical performance.







Eugene Ughetti is a percussionist, composer, conductor and artistic director of Speak Percussion. From solo experimental works through to large scale collaborations, Eugene is known for tackling complex and ambitious art music projects. Eugene has given international solo performances at MaerzMusik (Berlin), Roulette (New York), Lucerne Festival (Switzerland), SIPFest (Jakarta), National Museum (Singapore) and was concerto soloist with the Melbourne and Adelaide Symphony Orchestras.


