Sampling: "A process in which a sound is taken directly from a recorded medium and transposed onto a new recording." - *Grove Music Dictionary*

For modern musicians, using samples to create new works is an exciting new way to compose and create music that opens up thrilling new possibilities in sound.

This November, Speak Percussion and internationally renowned composer American composer Steven Takasugi (USA) will take students behind the scenes of a major sampling intensive, feeding into three very different and wildly ambitious projects - the *Living Instruments* virtual instrument collection, a live performance with bespoke electronic instruments, and the composition of a major performance work for electronics and live musicians.

Students will be introduced to a variety of innovative approaches to working with samples, and will be guided on beginning their own sample collections. Participants in this program will also be given priority access to our April 2022 Composition Intensive, where they'll compose new works from their sample collections and workshop their creations with Speak Percussion.

If you've ever wondered how sample collections are created, or how musicians and composers are working with pre-recorded sounds to create something new - this program is for you!

Optional: Participants will also be invited to attend the premiere performance of *Before Nightfall 14* at the Grainger Museum on December 4, the first major performance outcome of this ambitious sampling project.
