Join Sydney-based percussionist and artist Alon Ilisar and creative technologist Matt Hughes for a hands-on workshop exploring their interactive installation Cymbalism, a work that uses motion-controlled AirSticks technology to transform gesture into sound.

In this two-hour session, Alon and Matt will introduce the technology behind Cymbalism: how the AirSticks read movement in real time to manipulate cymbals, shape evolving sonic textures, and create visual feedback linked to performers' movements. Students will then have the chance to step into the installation and experiment with it themselves, exploring the relationship between body, sound, and space.

This workshop is suitable for secondary school students.
